Today, Sergio Zepeda represents the third generation of the family business. Combining traditional family methods with modern innovations in guitar design, he personally oversees the construction, setup, and final inspection of every instrument produced in the workshop.

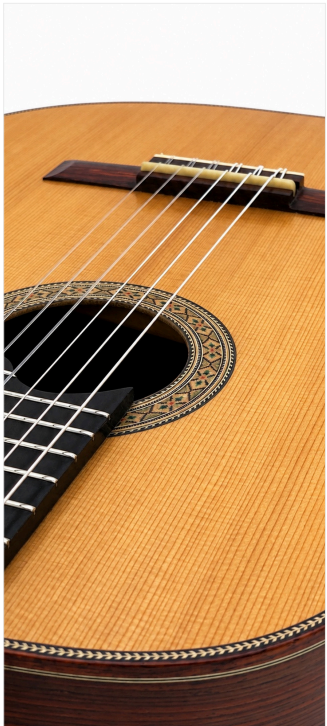
